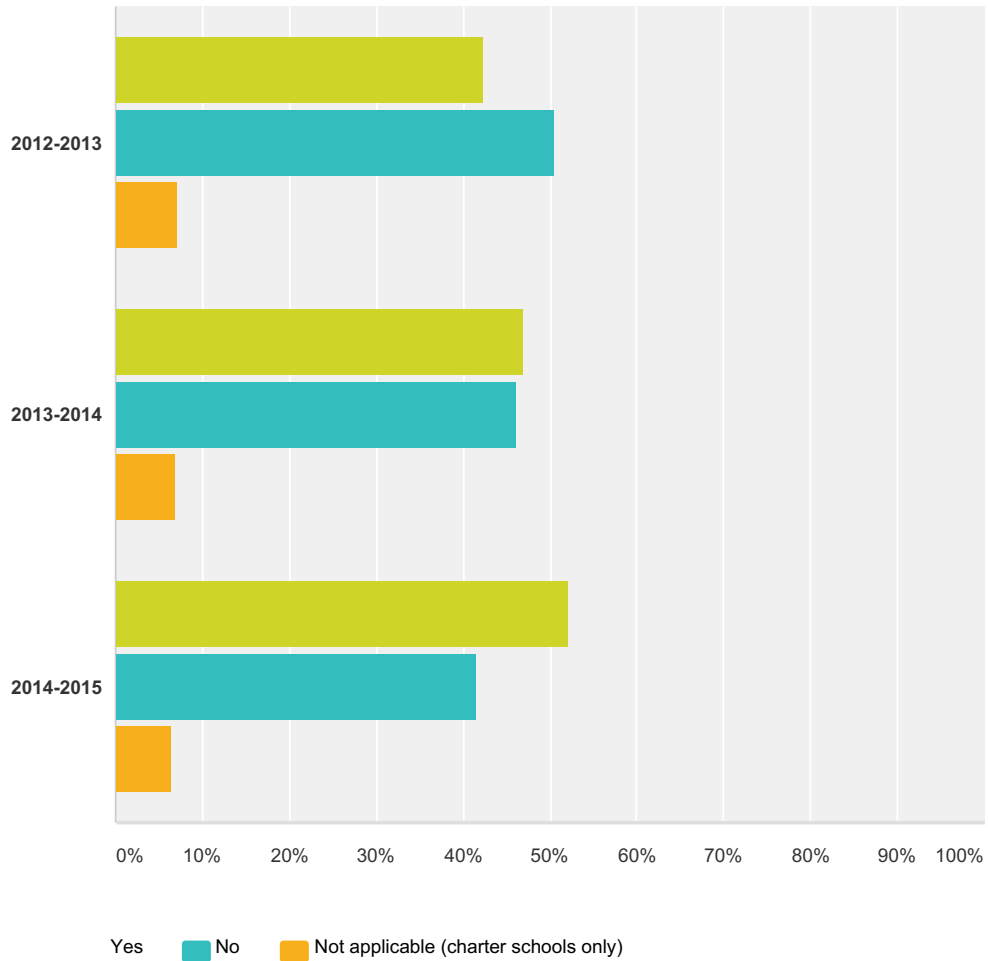

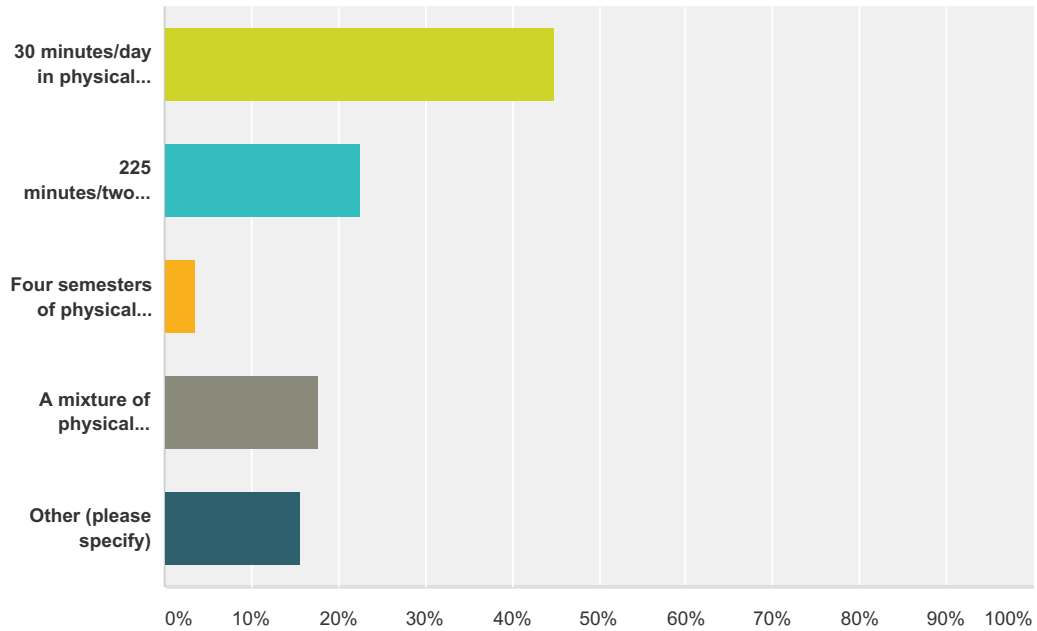

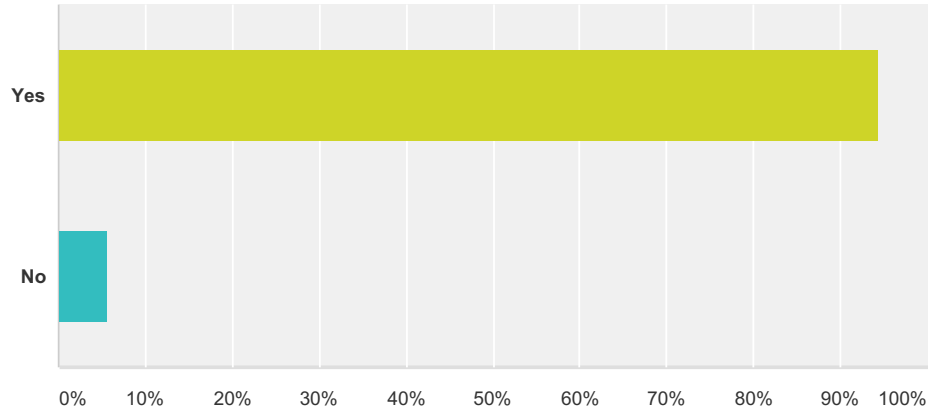

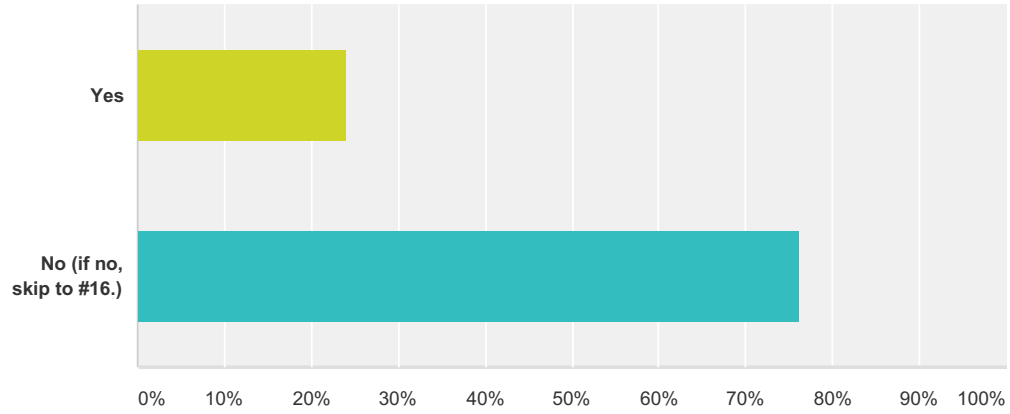

Q14 Does your district/charter school have a written policy that specifies the number of recess minutes students should participate in per day?

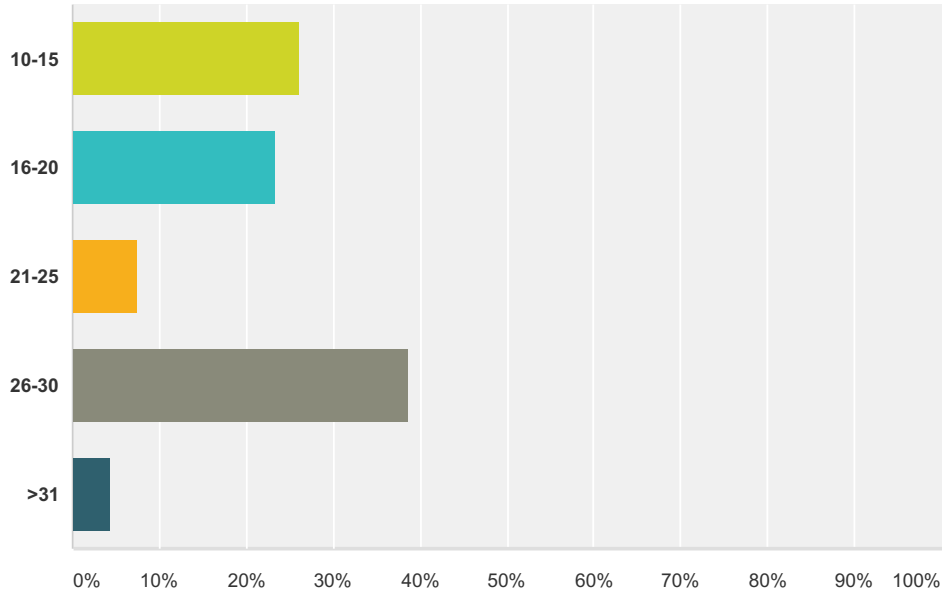

Q15 If you responded "yes" to question 14, how many minutes per day is required for recess in your school district?

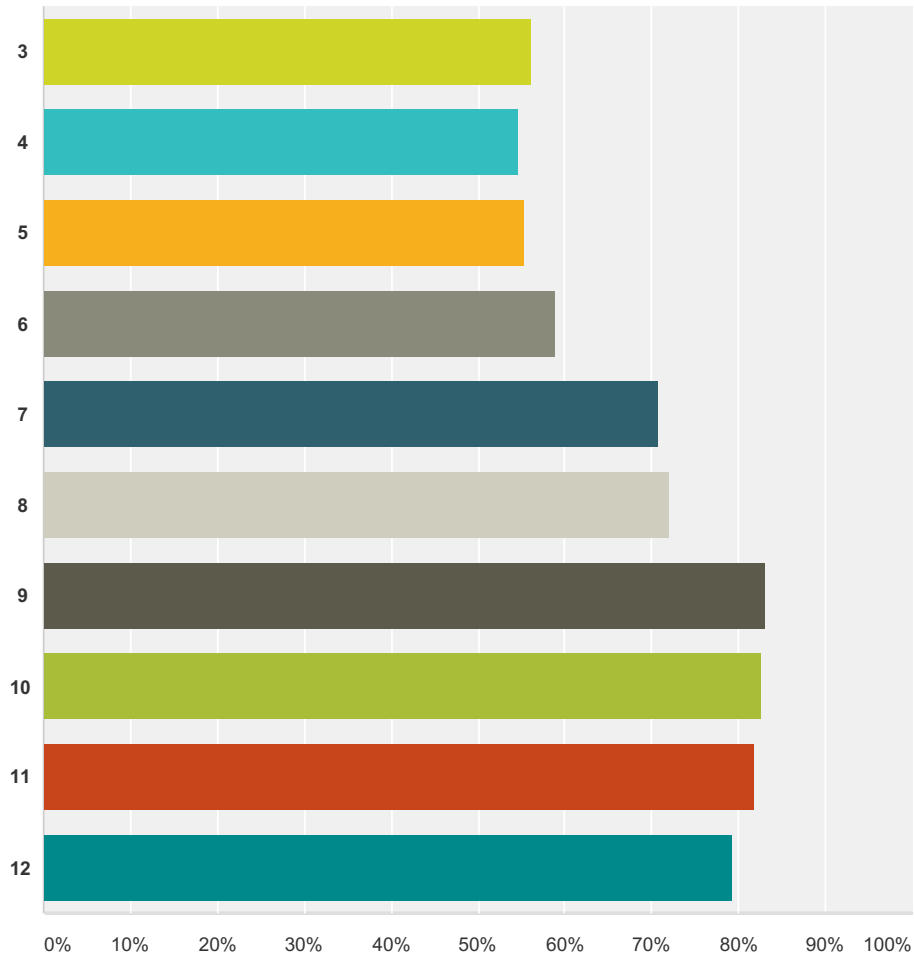

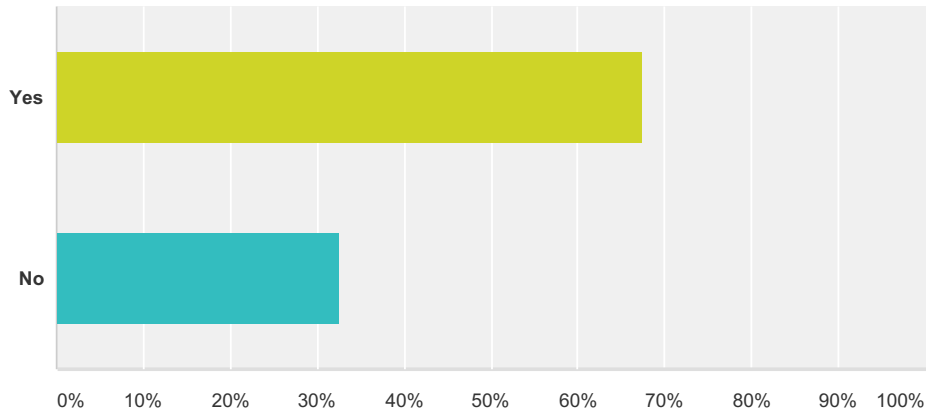

Q17 Does your district/charter school notify parents that they can request in writing their child's physical fitness assessment results at the end of the school year?

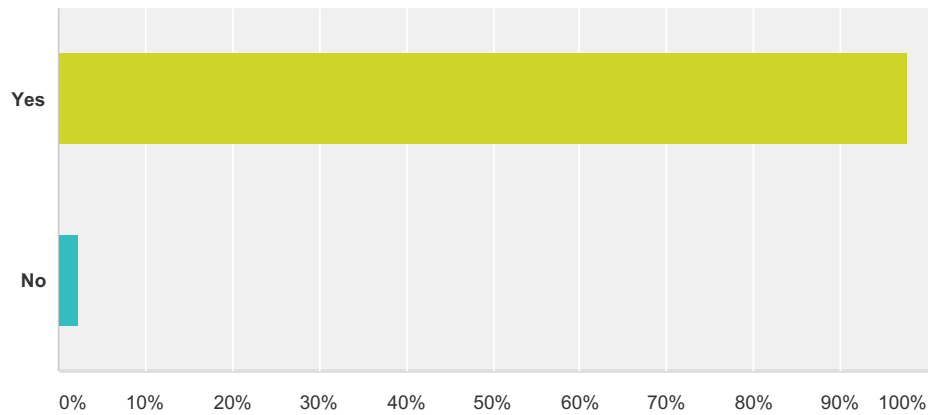

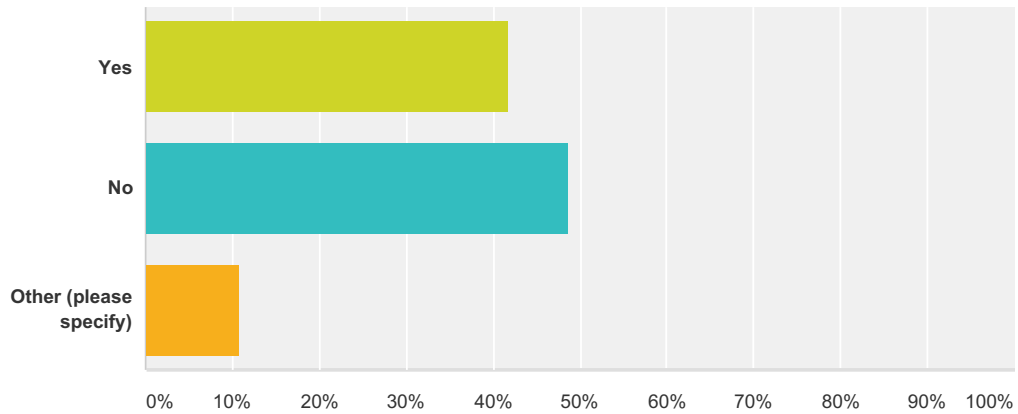

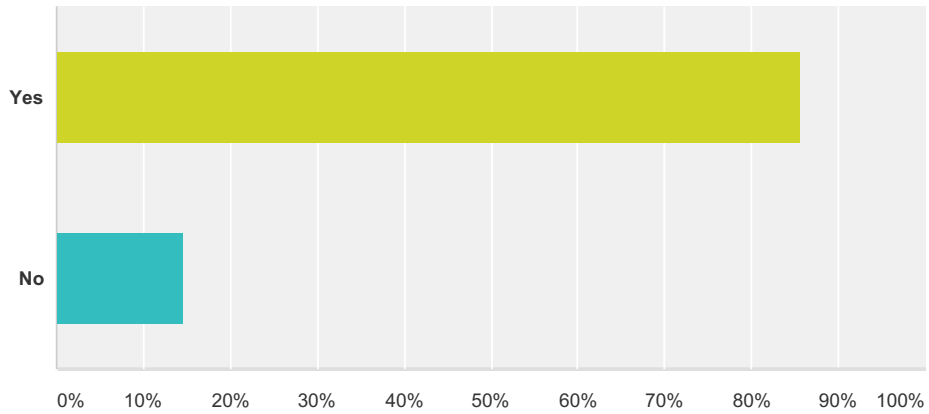

Q20 Does your district/charter school provide training for staff dealing with students at risk of suicide, recognizing early warning signs, and how to intervene effectively with students?

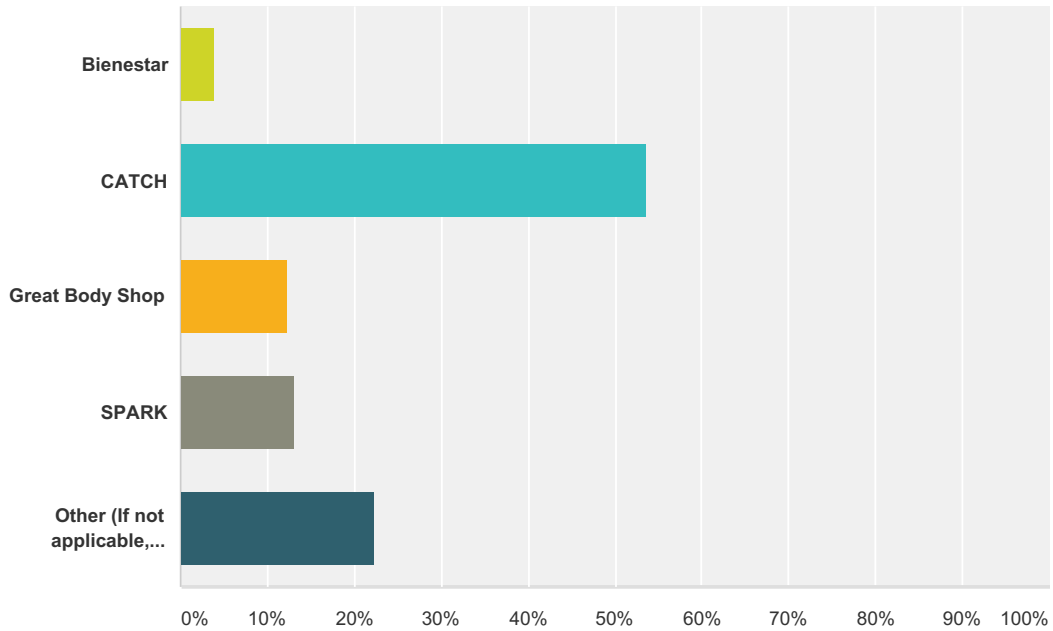

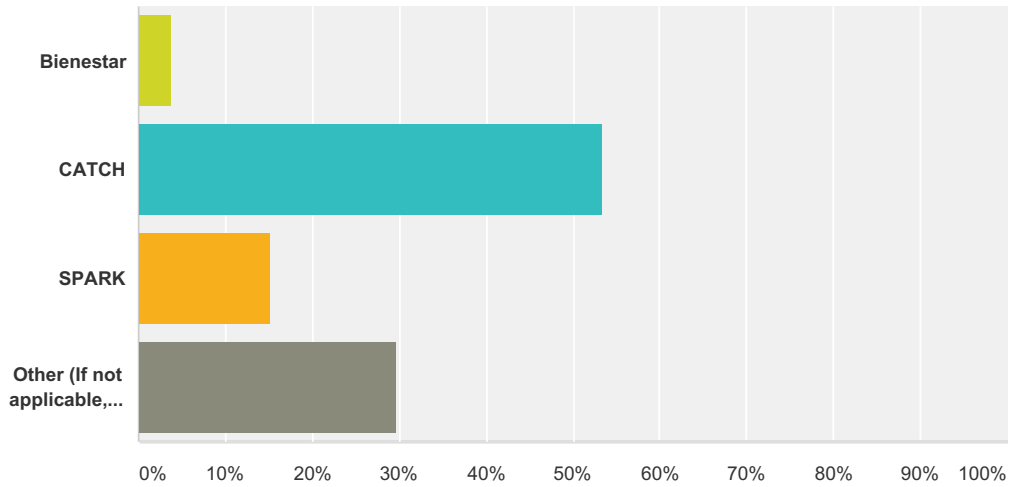

Q22 Which Coordinated School Health Program is your district/charter school implementing in middle and/or junior high schools?

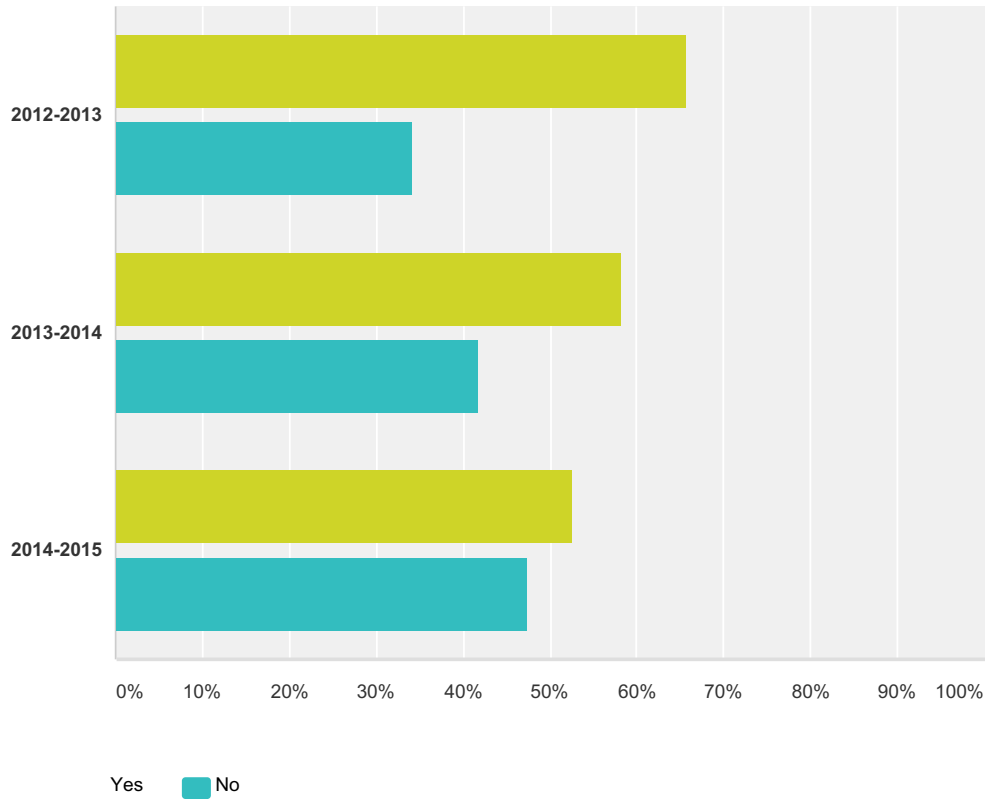

Q23 Did your district/charter school require health education as a graduation requirement for high school students in all graduation programs during the following academic years:

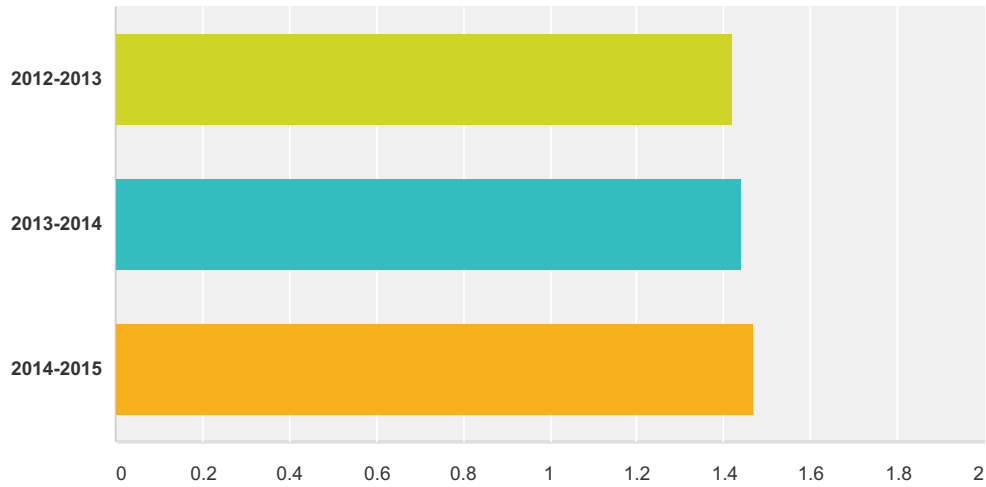

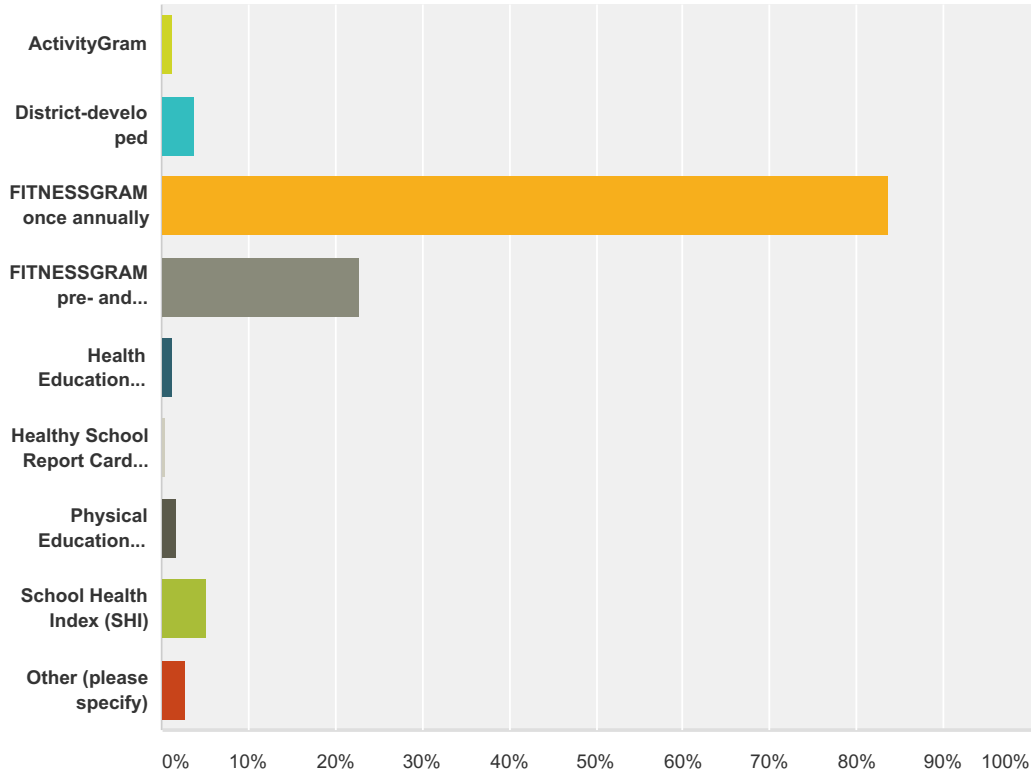
