Each rating is assigned a target TAAS passing percentage and a target dropout rate. A district or campus is assigned the rating for which each of its student groups meets both the target passing percentage for TAAS and the target dropout rate.

A district cannot be rated *Exemplary* or *Recognized* if one of its campuses is rated *Low-Performing*, if 1,000 or more of its students dropout, or if its dropout rate is 10 percent or higher.
