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<p>Each rating is assigned a target for each indicator. A district or campus is assigned the rating for which each of its student groups meets the targets for all indicators.</p> <p>For the TAKS indicator, each student group must meet the target passing percentage for every subject area.</p> <p>The Commended Performance indicator evaluates only two student groups: All Students and Economically Disadvantaged.</p> <p>The ELL Progress Indicator and Commended Performance indicator are used to assign only <i>Recognized</i> and <i>Exemplary</i> ratings.</p>

A district cannot be rated *Exemplary* or *Recognized* if one of its campuses is rated *Academically Unacceptable*, if it underreports 150 or more students, or if it underreports 3 percent or more of its student population.
