Social Studies Streamlining Work Group A Grade 6

1. 6th grade Social Studies TEKS have a lack of examples (ie: "Such As" and academic vocabulary) and are too broad and vague leading to a lack of specificity and consistency across the state

2. Vertical Alignment

Strands: History, Economics, Government, Citizenship allow for redundancies across the 6th grade curriculum; combining and streamlining language to provide more specificity.

Process skill alignment to 5th and 7th grade Social Studies

Suggestions for future work groups to address concerns:

- 1. Identify redundancies within the 6th grade World Cultures TEKS
- 2. Identify possible revisions for problematic TEKS to add specificity and consistency
- 3. Discuss instructional impact of suggested TEKS deletions
- 4. Review vertical alignment of TEKS within the strands of History, Economics, Government, Citizenship for redundancies and and ensure scaffolding of key social studies skills and knowledge
- . Deleting standards may not provide a solid foundation of social studies knowledge for future courses
