The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Nederland Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Nederland ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 4/28/2023 listing the following area(s) of noncompliance:

- IEP Development: Present Level of Academic & Academic Functional Performance (PLAAPF)
§34 CFR 300.320(a)(1)
- Transition: Measurable postsecondary goal
34 CFR §300.320(b)
Texas Administrative Code: §TAC 89.1055(I)(1)

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the abovementioned noncompliance.
