81st Legislature (2009)

STAAR[™]

- (1) STAAR assesses the **Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS)**
- (2) STAAR was required to be **predictive of postsecondary readiness**

Postsecondary Readiness

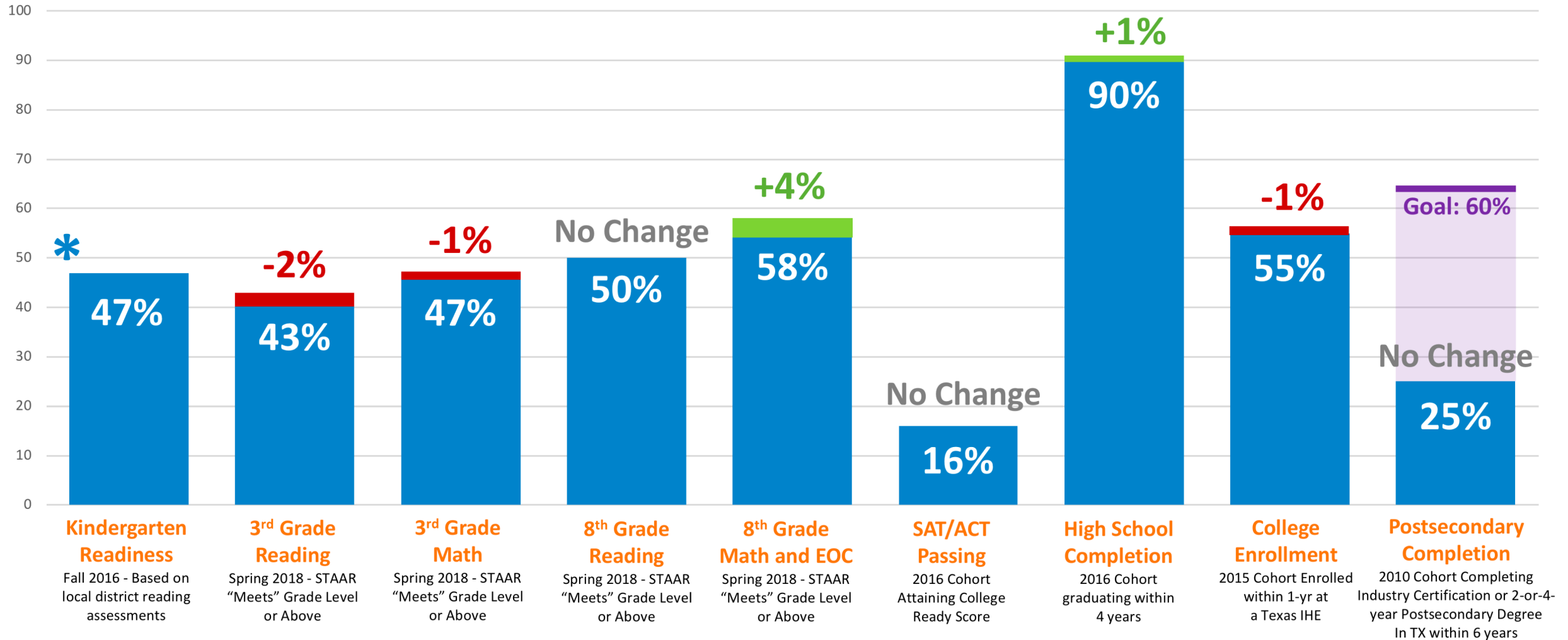
39.024(b) - TEA and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall ensure that the Algebra II and English III end-of-course assessment instruments required under Section 39.023(c) are developed to be capable of, beginning with the 2011-2012 school year, measuring college readiness.

Readiness Starts Early

39.0241 (a-2) (5) - The performance standards on the assessment instruments in each of grades three through seven, as determined based on studies under Section 39.0242, that correlate student performance in the same content area on the assessment instrument for each grade with student performance on the assessment instrument in the succeeding grade.

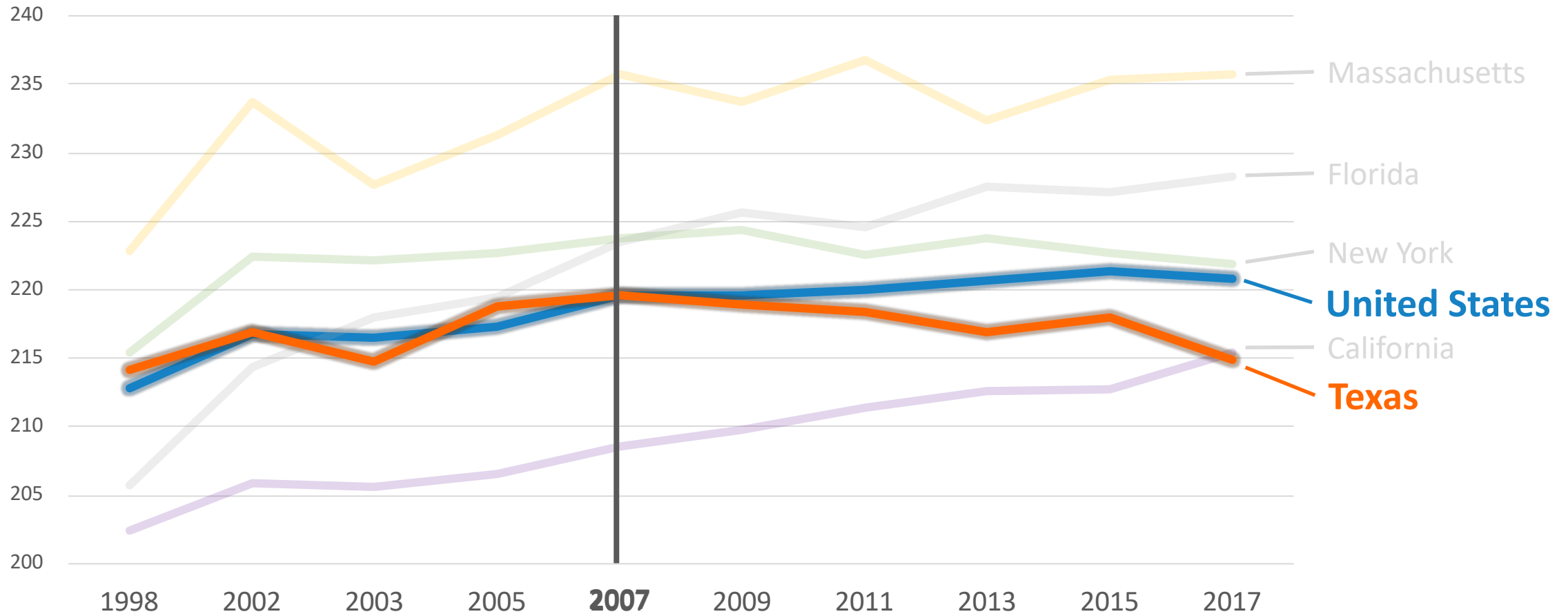

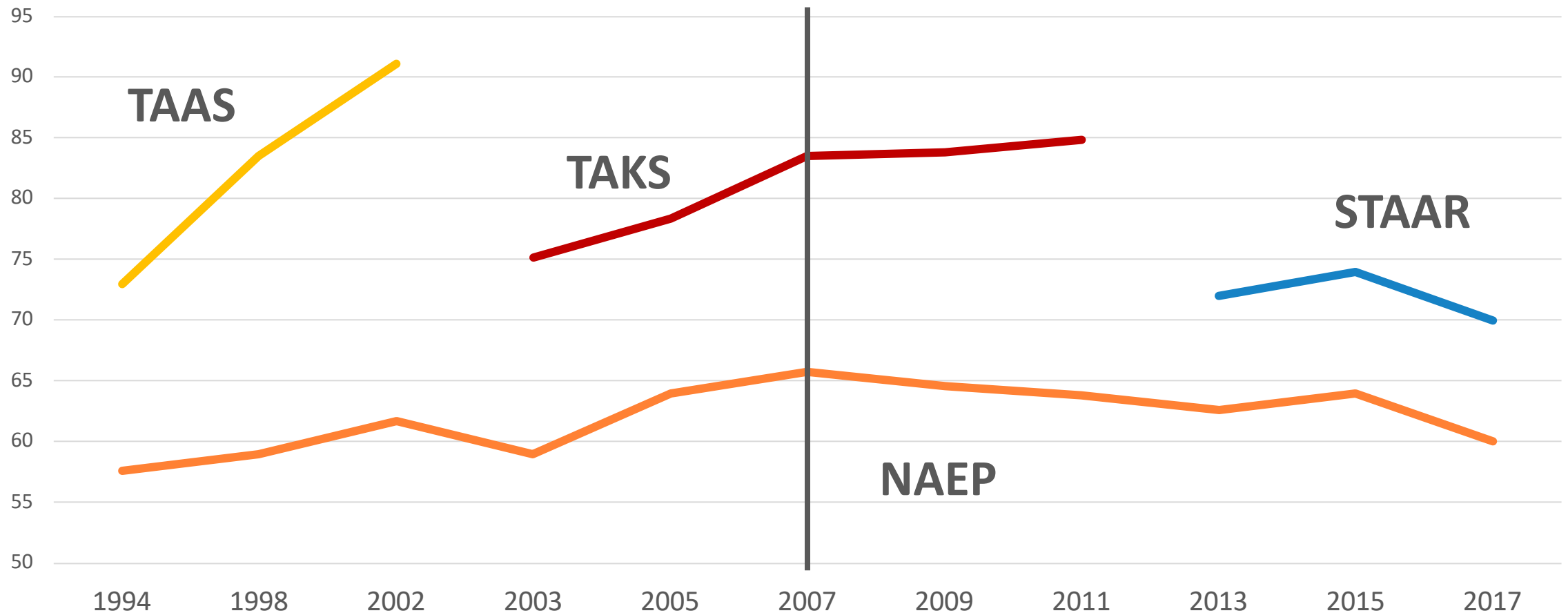
Reading Performance Is Declining According To NAEP

NAEP 4th Grade Reading Scores



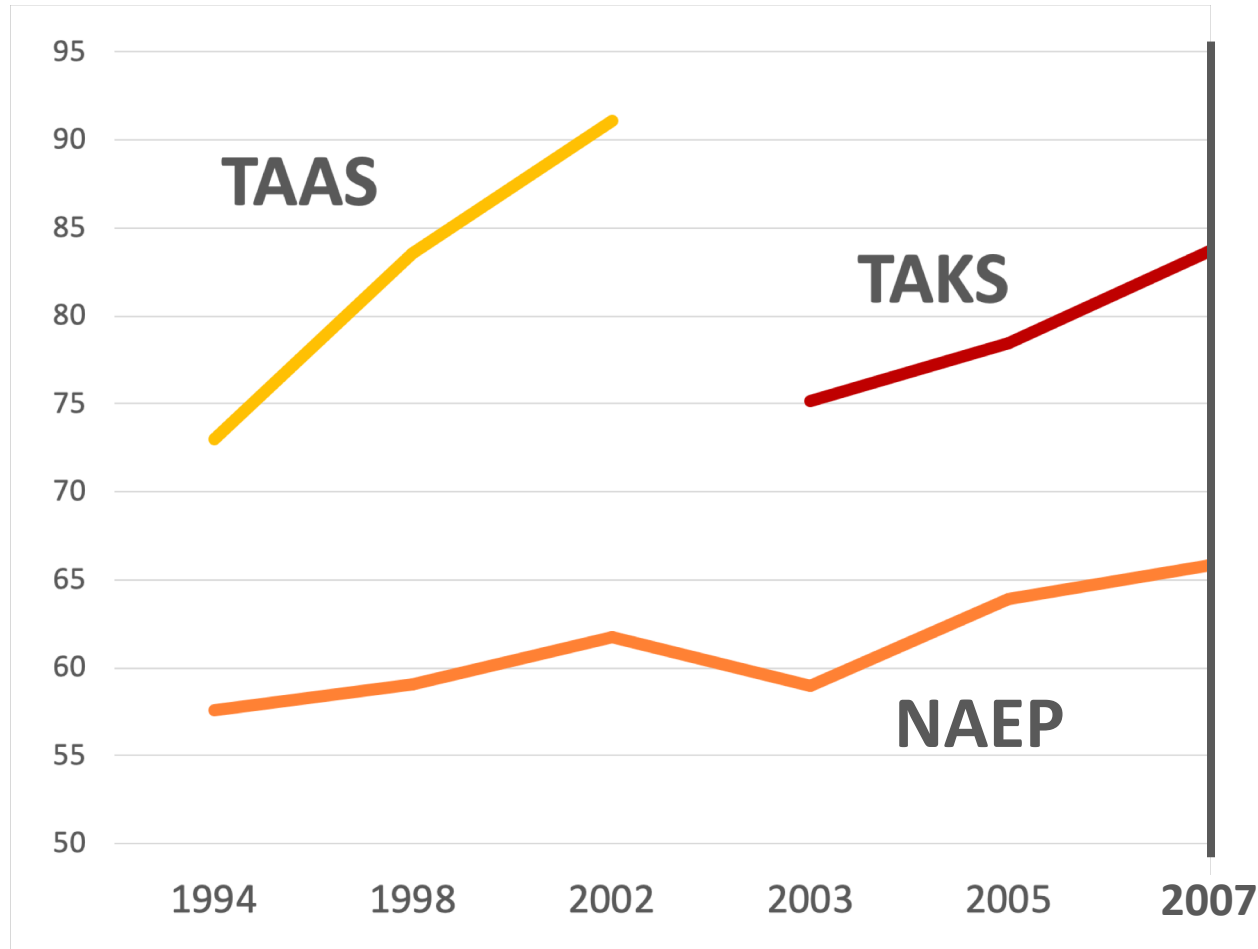
State Tests and NAEP Show Similar Trends

Percent of Students Meeting Standard in 4th Grade Reading

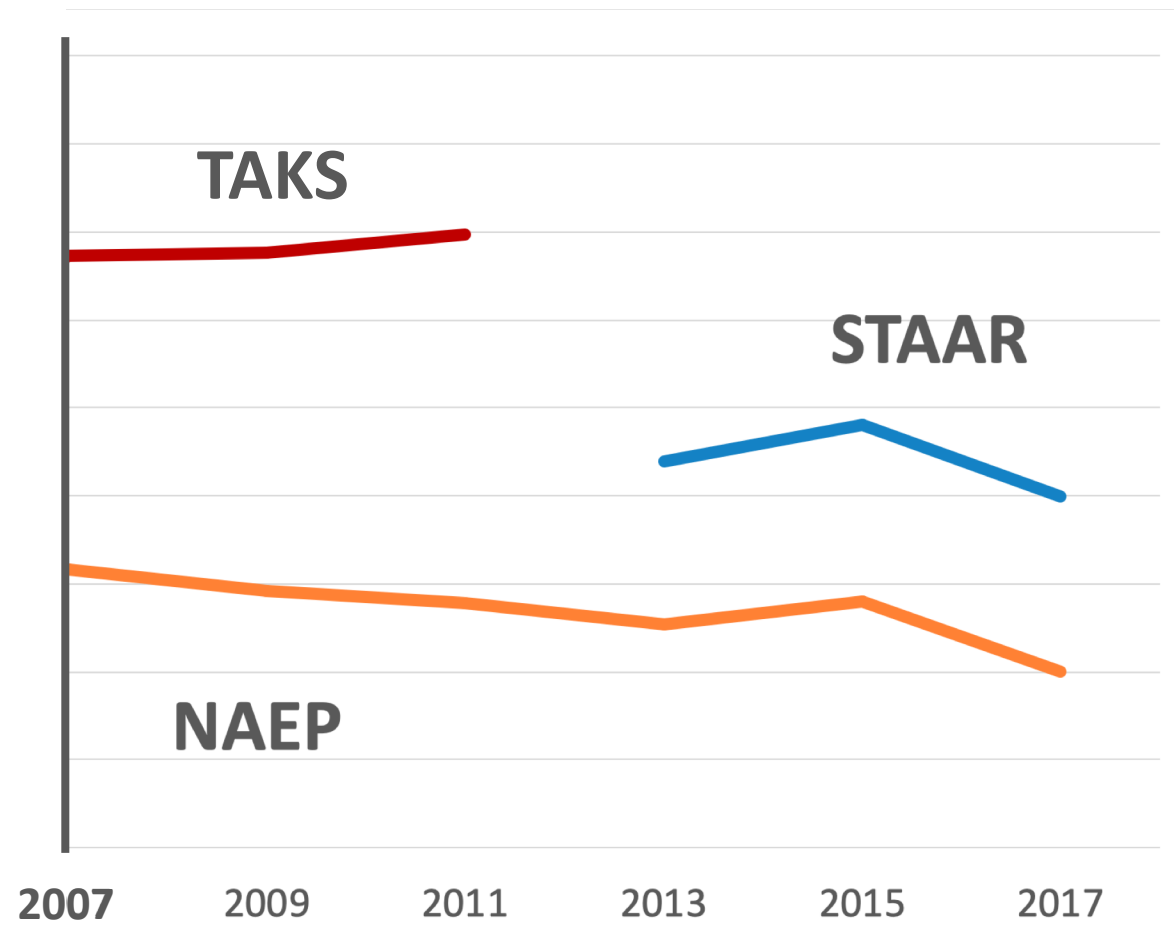

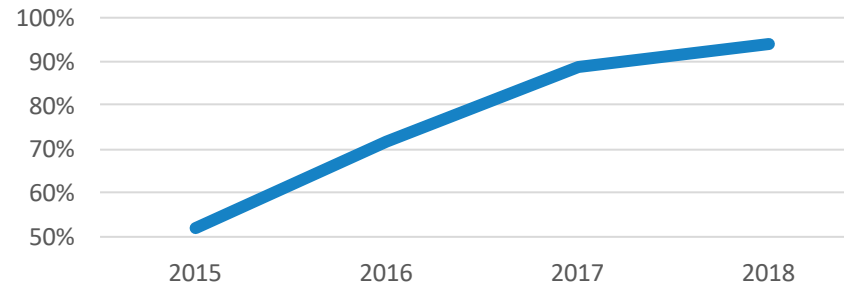

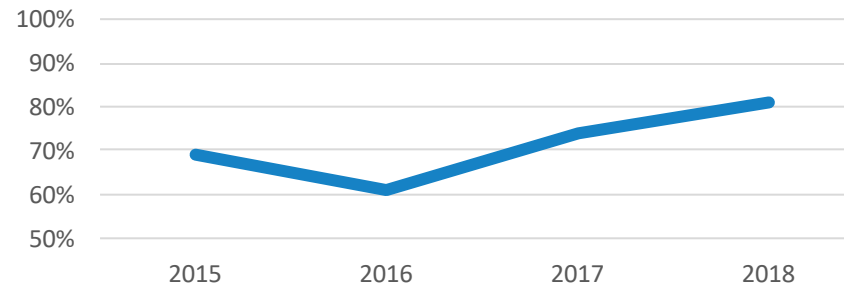

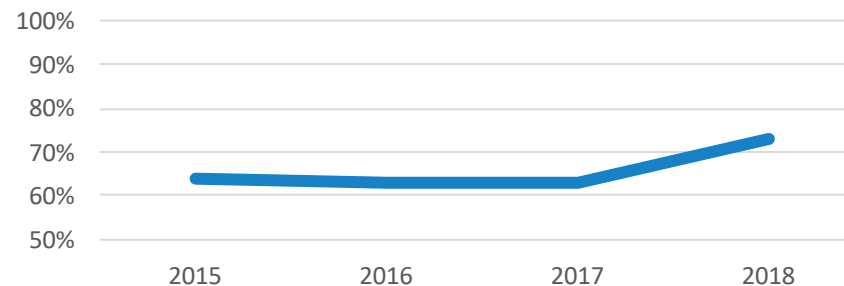

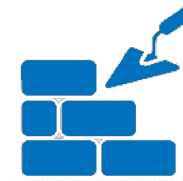

Developed with Texas teachers

STAAR items and passages are developed through a rigorous process. Committees of Texas teachers approve items and passages based on four key criteria.

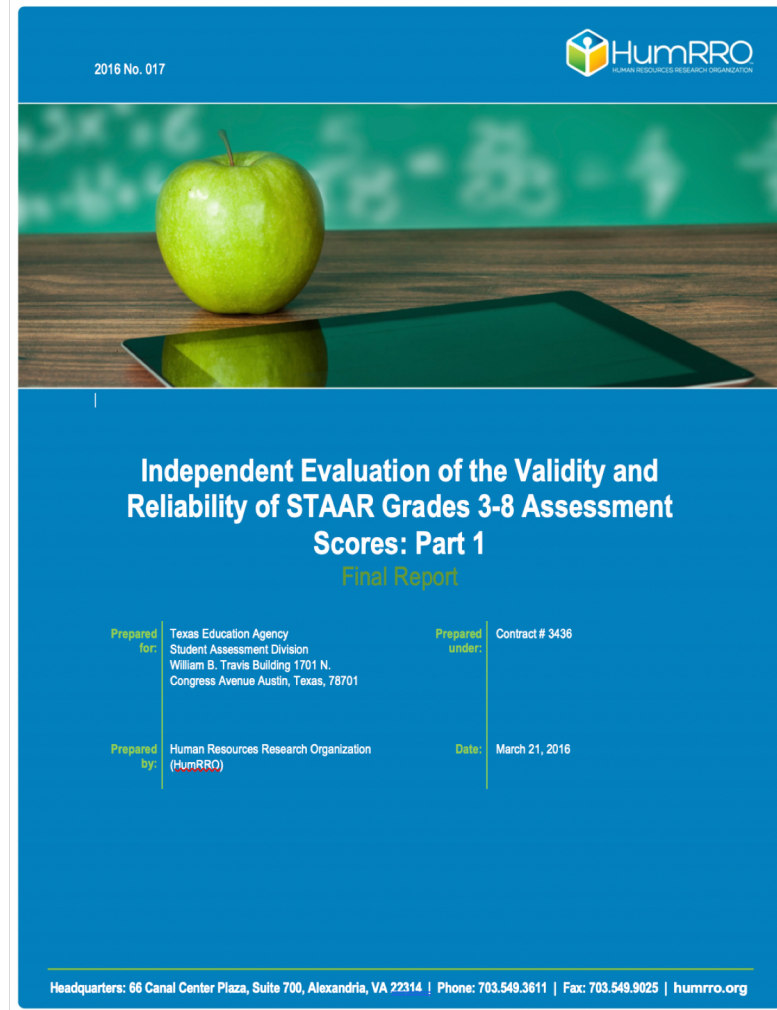
Lexile And Their Peers



Computer-based Algorithm

Quantitative analysis of words per sentence and word frequency, etc., based on the middle 50% of texts and students today.

Grade Level Has Been Independently Validated



STAAR Validity Has Been Verified, Including Grade-Level Appropriateness

House Bill 743, Huberty – 84th Legislature

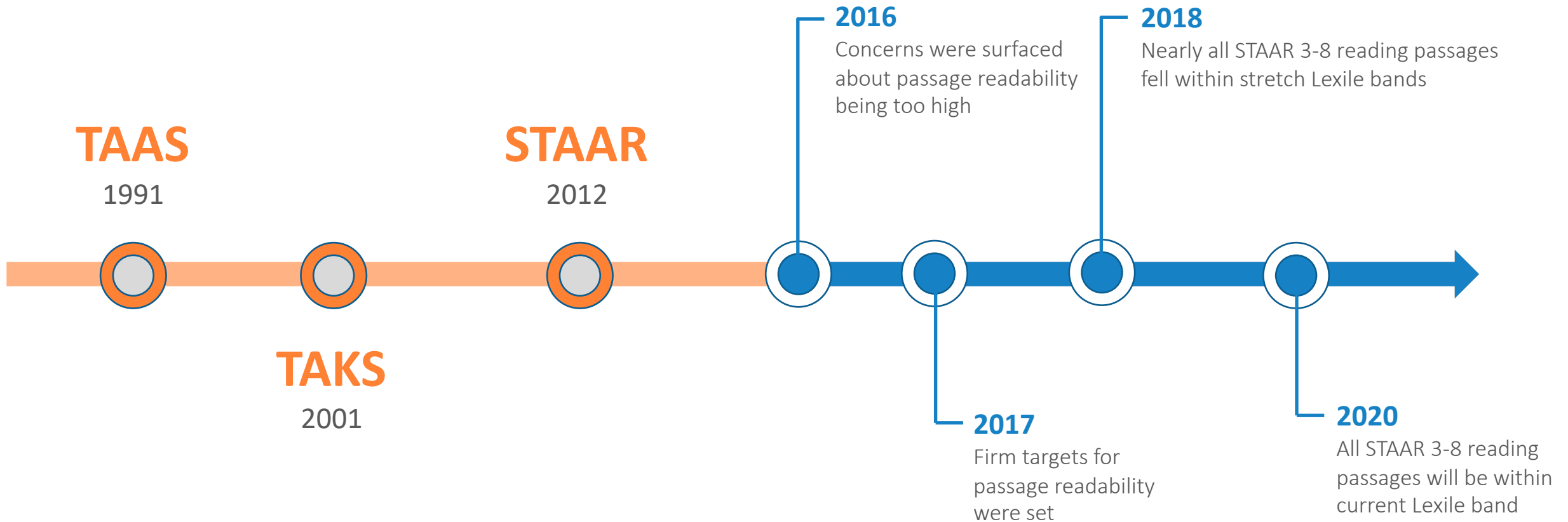
§39.023(a-11) - “The assessment instrument must, on the basis of empirical evidence, be determined to be **valid and reliable** by an entity that is independent of the agency and of any other entity that developed the assessment instrument.”

Findings: STAAR was found to be valid. The evaluation included confirming **“test bears a strong association with on-grade curriculum requirements.”**

Using Readability Algorithms When Selecting Passages

Pre 2016, multiple readability algorithms, including Lexile, were consulted to inform passage selection.

Post 2016, the agency adopted specific Lexile goals.
