The 86th Texas Legislature passed House Bill (HB) 3 and HB 3906, which require the formation of the following five advisory committees to support public education:

- Reading Standards K-3 Advisory Committee
- Special Education Allotment Advisory Committee
- Compensatory Education Allotment Advisory Committee
- Financial Aid Advisory Committee
- Assessment Educator Advisory Committee

In accordance with House Bill 3906, Commissioner of Education Mike Morath has formed the **Assessment Educator Advisory Committee** to advise the commissioner and the agency regarding the development of academically appropriate assessment instruments.
