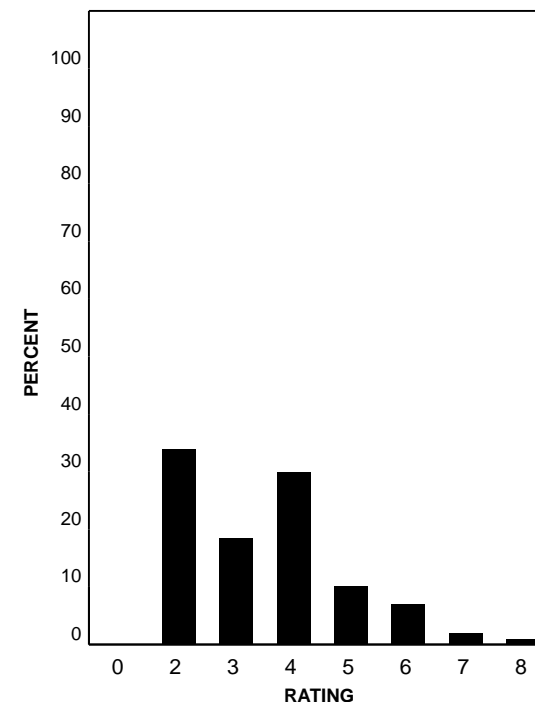

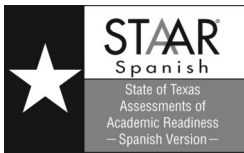


Expository Composition
