The TEA is required to publish the APR on its website and report it to the public. This requirement is based on federal regulation [34 CFR §300.602\(b\)\(1\)\(i\)\(B\)](#), the implementing authority [20 U.S.C. §1416\(b\)\(2\)\(C\)](#) and federal guidance from the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) [QA 23-01](#).

State Annual Determination

The U.S. Department of Education issued the 2024 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), Part B, Determination for Texas on June 21, 2023, for the FFY 2022 SPP/APR Submission and concluded that Texas “Meets Requirements.” This determination means that Texas is meeting the requirements and purposes of IDEA.
