The Texas Education Agency (TEA) would like to invite school and district leaders to recommend distinguished elementary school teachers, specialists, and/or principals to be included in the Texas Distinguished Educator Recognition Pool. These educators may be considered for special statewide recognition programs and demonstrate the following:

1. Exceptional educational talent as evidenced by effective instructional practices and student learning;
2. Exemplary educational accomplishments beyond the classroom that provide models of excellence for the profession;
3. Early-to-mid career educational experience that demonstrates long-range potential for professional and policy leadership; and
4. An engaging and inspiring presence that motivates and impacts students, colleagues, and the community.

Candidates must be elementary school teachers, specialists, and principals who have a **minimum of five years** of experience in education. Of special interest are educators who are outstanding and have not received other recognition.
