Subject: New Training Activities for the Texas Assessment Program

To the Regional and District Testing Coordinator Addressed:

This communication is to inform you of new training activities for the Texas Assessment Program.

The Texas Education Agency (TEA), in partnership with Cambium Assessment, Inc. (CAI) and Pearson, is developing a series of trainings to support a successful transition to new assessment vendors for the 2021–2022 school year. Part of this transition includes a new Texas Assessment Learning Management System (LMS) that will launch on July 12, 2021.

The new LMS will contain training resources for all state assessments: State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR®), STAAR Interim Assessments, STAAR Alternate 2, Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System (TELPAS), and TELPAS Alternate. With this new system, users will be able to register for training events and educator committee meetings, access recorded webinars and slide decks, and complete online training.

Key System Releases	Description	Date
Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE)	TIDE is used for administrative tasks like managing student enrollments, maintaining demographic data, setting student test attributes, ordering and tracking materials, and other activities.	Friday July 30, 2021
Test Delivery System (TDS)	TDS is the application that enables students to take online tests.	Monday August 16, 2021
Centralized Reporting System (CRS)	CRS is the application that allows users to access student reports and campus and district aggregate data for state assessments.	Monday August 16, 2021
