The 86th Legislature passed Senate Bill (SB) 11 which created an annual school safety allotment to help fund equipment, programs, and training related to school safety and security. Further, the 87th Legislature enacted House Bill (HB) 1525 which included provisions requiring the Texas Education Agency to publish reports regarding the programs, personnel, resources, and other purposes detailing how funds were used by local education agencies (LEAs). **To meet this requirement, please complete the following questions related to the 2023 fiscal year no later than 11:59p.m. on Monday, February 12, 2024.**
